

## Trout in the Classroom Program Application 2011-2012 School Year

Dear Educator:

The purpose of the Trout in the Classroom program (TIC) is to raise awareness about Idaho's aquatic resources by providing a hands-on learning opportunity for Idaho students in grades 4 through 12. Trout or salmon will be raised in the classroom over the course of three months and then released into a local water (stream, river, lake). **Interested teachers must completely fill out this application before August 15<sup>th</sup> 2011.**

Teachers will be notified of entrance into TIC in October, 2011. Once selected, you will be notified by your local Trout in the Classroom coordinator and all the information needed to start this program will be provided. This includes a TIC curriculum guide. Teachers begin raising fish in December or January depending on the region of Idaho where you live. Note that this program is extremely popular and we have a waiting list from the 2010-2011 school year to fill first.
